Core ECT1 afternoons with small peer group discussion, theory, practical ideas and surgeries with an Expert to meet individual needs. These are planned as face-to-face sessions.



Additional

Our sessions are designed to support and complement the statutory requirements for the ECF. Transform sessions will provide practical and local context to the national ECF programme.



Triads — virtual or face-toface visits to other schools and settings, fostering, collaboration, sharing Teaching and Learning reflections.



School-based mentors receive training and termly meets to support them with their role. Half-termly mentor bulletins detail session key themes.

CONTENT in 2021/22 - Each session will be accompanied by resources on a google drive link

The 5 key aspects of the Early Career Framework (National from 2021) are integrated into all sessions — see over Facilitators draw upon research and evidence for each session. ECT1s receive short think-pieces & videos as pre-learning. Each session will develop personal and professional behaviours through @OurBest & Transform Applied ECT1s build a learning portfolio throughout the year. Each session will have dedicated time for reflection built in.
